

# **NOTICE**

**In order to protect the safety of our most vulnerable patients, Monesmith & Wood Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery is implementing the following requirements for our patients to be treated in our office during this unprecedented time with respect to the Coronavirus pandemic:**

1. All patients and caregivers will be required to use hand sanitizer at our front desk before filling out any necessary paperwork.
2. Only patients and necessary caregivers will be allowed in the waiting room. Please do not bring any other people, especially senior citizens or other children with you to your appointment.
  - a. Necessary caregivers include one parent of a minor child, one driver for patients who are to be sedated, and one nursing home or hospital health care worker accompanying a patient.
  - b. All other people accompanying our patients will be asked to wait in their car.
3. Only patients will be allowed to enter any patient care area of our office past our waiting room with the following exceptions:
  - a. One parent will need to accompany their child to our consultation area during their surgery consultation appointment.
  - b. One parent will be allowed to accompany their child to our treatment area if the child is under 10-years-old and is undergoing a procedure under local anesthesia only.
4. If you are feeling ill, please DO NOT come to your appointment and DO NOT enter our office. Please call us and let us know you are feeling ill and reschedule your appointment after you have self-quarantined for at least 14 days after feeling well again.
